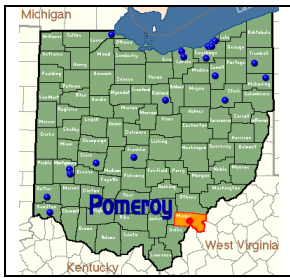
Did You Know

Safety Topic

Roger Black had our safety talk for the August meeting. Roger presented a talk on LP Gas tanks. There has been a concern about the LP Gas tanks that you can exchange. There is a possibility that due to some drug dealers using these tanks in their meth labs and injecting byproducts of the process back into the tanks they may be unsafe to use. These byproducts can cause corrosion of the tank valve assembly. If you notice any discoloration of the valve don't use the tank.

Also Roger discussed bee stings and what to do while on a ride if someone suffers a bee sting.
